6.1	<p>2019 Structure + Direction Primary Structure – will be a bit late due to the fact the we are currently overstaffed. We have been carrying an extra teacher to run a few programs and to reduce the split classes but this is not sustainable. We have been working with the Department, they have done a budget review and have looked at the trend over the last few years and we are over staffed in Primary Teachers and to reduce this we have tried to find a local solution but unfortunately this has not completely fixed the shortfall in the budget. If there are no more local solutions then all teachers, except specialist teachers e.g. Science, Language and Physical Education, will have to apply for their positions in the school.
